Infection Control Program

by Dowites 78 OT Complex at Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi

ealthcare-associated infection is the major cause of morbidity and mortality in hospitals. Infection control practices encompass many aspects with hand hygiene as the single most important step in the prevention of multiplication of infection in hospital settings. Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi has introduced a comprehensive infection control program to prevent patients and employees from Hospital Acquired Infections (HAI).

The workshop was held at the Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi's Dowites78 Operation Theatre Complex. Infectious Diseases and Waste Management Spokesperson of Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi, Dr. Gul Munir Vistro said that the Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi's administration had introduced a comprehensive mechanism to save visiting patients, outpatients, patient attendants, doctors, nurses, paramedical staff and other support staff from hospital acquired infections.

"An estimated 20 to 25 percent patients infected from health facilities during treatment every year in developing countries including Pakistan by not following Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs); however, the ratio of hospitals acquired infections is very low in European countries," he said.

He further said that vaccination of hospital employees against hepatitis B, provision of guidelines regarding standard practices of infection, promotion of research in infection control, occupational health and safety, public awareness, maintaining data of hospital acquired infections and infection control practices are not followed.

Keeping in view this situation, infection control program has been introduced at Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi to identify risk factors for infection, provide education about infection control to healthcare workers, decrease the burden of hospital acquired infections such as surgical site, ventilator acquired pneumonia, bloodstream infection, and urinary tract infection.

He said that the Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi administration had opened Infectious Diseases OPD for treatment of patients suffering from infectious diseases where Assistant Professor Azizullah Khan Dihloo had been posted as head of Infectious Diseases OPD. He claimed that billion of rupees could be saved annually in Pakistan by spending on preventive and promotion strategies like European countries.

Transmission of infection in healthcare facilities can be prevented through the application of standard and transmission based precautions such as; waste management, linen, and disposal of syringe needles and sterilization of instruments. The Dowites78 Operation Theatre Complex is following adequate procedures for the routine cleaning and care, disinfection of environmental surfaces and compliance of infection control procedures. •





Oral Cancer

A Burden on Health Care System

Oral Cancer is a serious and deadly disease. The general public needs to know about the existence of oral cancer and it's early signs.



ancer is defined "Most Dangerous" if untreated. It will eventually kill a person for sure, but many, if timely diagnosed, can be cured. It is becoming a serious health threat; especially in Asian countries including Pakistan. The rapidly growing disease has the greatest health burden & a leading cause of death.

There were over 3 million cancer cases registered in the year 2000 & 2 million people died due to cancer in Asian Pacific region. Forecasted statistics for the year 2020 says that there will be 7.1 million new cancer cases arises in the region (if existing prevention & management strategies remain unchanged).

Oral cancer (OC) is the most common cancer in Pakistan. Our doctors are dealing with multiple oral cancer cases on daily basis. Be it 42 years old Sarfaraz from Liaquatabad, 55 years old Bahadur from Jacobabad, 43 years old Abbas or 53 years old Sofia, all have one thing in common "Oral Cancer". Mainly courtesy goes to "Gutka" or the stuff of similar kind. Most of the patients suffering from oral cancers are usually young.

All of them are in the most productive age group, their children and spouse are depedent on them, their parents

need them & they should have been contributing to the society. Instead they become a big liability for their loved ones. The whole domestic scenario changes when a person develops cancer. The sufferings not only confine to financial issues but there are huge psycho-social impacts as well. The volume of oral cancer patients is enormous at Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi, as the cancer patients are occupying 30% to 50% of beds in Department of ENT Head and Neck Surgery. They stay for much longer time in ward & consume extraordinary time during surgery which is really exhausting for doctors & OT staff. Still, despite of some tireless & valiant efforts from doctors to eradicate disease, the monstrous cancer does not go away or comes back after sometime, increasing the misery of patients.

Increasing number of new cancer cases is adding the burden on health care system. This tremendous burden is affecting the quality of already compromised health care facilities especially in Pakistan. Some common cancers like breast cancer, different blood cancers, some of GI cancers, etc. are caused by factors which are non-modifiable, while some of the common cancers such as Cancers of Oral Cavity, Bronchial cancers and Laryngeal cancers are caused by factors which are definitely modifiable.

Three major classes of factors influencing the incidence of cancer are:

- · Hereditary: Cannot be modified
- Environmental: Potentially modifiable e.g. exposure to extensive sunlight & carcinogens exist as pollutants in air, water, food, soil, etc.
- Behavioral: Definitely modifiable e.g. tobacco & alcohol consumption, nutrition, obesity, some medical treatments like radiations etc. It is estimated that 75% - 80% of cancers are caused by environmental & behavioral factors combined.

Around 33% cancer cases are linked with Tobacco exposure. It is responsible for around 22% of cancer deaths. 1.7 million Deaths in 2008 were caused by tobacco. Head & Neck Cancers refer to a group of biologically similar cancers arising from mucosal lining of lip, oral cavity, nose, sinuses, nasopharynx, oropharynx or larynx. Around 90% of them are Squamous Cell Carcinoma. They have a high tendency to spread to neck nodes.

The most recent data from different centers of Pakistan reflect the trend of rapidly increasing number of Head and Neck Cancer. Unfortunately there are no comprehensive database / registries available especially for cancer in Pakistan. Therefore Our current knowledge is based on sporadically available institutional based data.

A cancer patient causes increased burden in many ways:

- Longer hospital stay / increased bed occupancy
- High cost of treatment
- · Increased number of hours spend by doctors upon them
- · Consuming resources in rehabilitation
- Compromised functional capabilities and productivity of patients
- · Psycho-social disturbance

In Karachi 36% of males and 21% females chew pan or pan with tobacco whereas tobacco smoking is practiced by 36% males and 9% females. The incidence of preventable cancers can be markedly cut down by some simple measures and introducing strict laws against advertisement, sale and supply of causative agents. These measures should be implicated by the government & fully supported by effective media campaign.

Oral, Gastric, Prostate, Breast, and Colorectal cancers are the major types of cancer prevailing in Pakistan.

But we can limit the incidence of Oral Cancer by:



Limiting the usage of smoking or no smoking at all



Using more fruits and vegetables in your diet



Limiting or prohibiting the use of alcohol

Overall, 10.5 adults per 100,000 will develop Oral Cancer.

First Int'l Esophagogastric Symposium

Held at Dowites 78 OT Complex, Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi



he country's first esophagogastric symposium was organized by DUHS in collaboration with Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi. Vice chancellor of Dow University of Health Sciences Prof. Saeed Quraishy was the chief guest for the symposium and shared his experience on the country's first esophagogastric symposium regarding laparoscopic surgery with the participants. He addressed after achieving excellence in robotic and laparoscopic surgeries, "We have to look at the changing future scenario where technology was coming to help saving human lives".

He said that the Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi was the first hospital in public sector that offered the facility of robotic surgery for several years. He said, at present the DUHS was the largest and comprehensive health science system in Pakistan which had



clinical care and research expertise for more than six decades.

In the five day symposium practical training was accorded at the Dowites78 OT Complex of the Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi while experts from across the country and abroad shared their experiences at the country's first esophagogastric symposium regarding robotic and laparoscopic surgery with the participants.

Prof. Muhammad Saeed Quraishy urged the participants on learning modern techniques from the experts of United Kingdom, United Arab Emirates and Singapore regarding Esophagogastric surgery.

Foreign experts, Dr. Yousuf iftikhar, Dr. Amir Khan, Dr. Khurshid Akhtar, Dr. Asif Chaudhry, Dr. Javed Raza, and Dr. Basheer shared their experiences esophagogastric diseases and related treatment methods. Experts from Pakistan, Dr. Mumtaz Mehr, Dr. Inaam Pal, Brig. Bilal Umer, Dr. Wasey Jilani, Dr. Nadeem Khurshidi, Dr. Hasnain Zafar, Dr. Shahab Abid, Dr. Arsalan Ahmed and Dr. Amir Bilal were also there to share their experiences.

Chairperson of the symposium Dr. Sajida Ouraishy said that in the first three days of the symposium learning sessions

were held regarding robotic and laparoscopic surgery. During that period, several patients were operated free of cost at the Dowites78 OT Complex Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi.

were observed by the participants while question answer sessions were also conducted. .









O: WHAT MAKES DOWITES78 OT COMPLEX DIFFERENT FROM OTHER OPERATION THEATRES IN CIVIL AND OTHER HOSPITALS?

Dr. Bilal: An operation theatre complex is the "heart" of any major surgical hospital. Dowites78 OT Complex is a state-of-the-art, integrated and modern operation theatre complex for elective surgeries at the Dr. Ruth K. M. Pfau Civil Hospital Karachi.

We have 14 operation theatres fully equipped with requisite modern equipments including OR-1 designated for Robotic surgeries, which is the only one in Pakistan. Our Gastrointestinal Centre, owned by DOTs, is fully functional Endoscopy Suite where ERCP, upper and lower endoscopies, sigmoidoscopy and colonoscopies are performed on a regular basis completely Free of cost.

Q: WHAT CHALLENGES DID YOU FACE SINCE THE DAY DOTS CAME INTO EXISTENCE?

Dr. Bilal: I believe that without careful management and distribution, there's a good chance that every organization will face difficulties. It was a challenge in initial years to run DOTs because we were running out of funds rapidly. This was the time when we realized that there was a dire need to develop a sustained and secured system for continued supply of funds. Hence, external organizations, philanthropists stepped in to take their social responsibility and undermine recovery in multiple ways. Here I must mention support of Edhi Foundation, without which it could not be possible for me to make this complex functioning smoothly.

As we are running a public-private partnered set up at OT Complex, our main objective is to play a significant role in surrounding needy community. O: WHAT SIGNIFICANT CHANGES DO YOU FORESEE IN THE NEAR FUTURE?
