Message from General Secretary




Field Trip Fajar Academy



Ceremony in the honor of Class of 1991



A Miracle- Successful surgery of a complicated case

The incident took place when a 12 year old boy fell from 4th floor of his house on an erected iron rod which pass through and through in Epigastrium. He was brought to Accident & Emergency. There was tenderness in his upper abdomen. Necessary



resuscitation was done and the blood products arranged. The patient was finally shifted to OT. Findings revealed that there was rent in diaphragm posterior. The iron rod was passed through and through perforation of left lobe of liver. The patient was successfully operated by team of Surgical unit III. Post OP patient remained in HDU for 2 days. By the grace of God and successful effort of our qualified surgeons, he was discharged on 8TH post operative day.

Word of Thanks to DOTS

We, Department of Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery at Civil Hospital Karachi, are a 35 bedded unit. We are biggest tertiary care Plastic Surgery unit of Sindh and Pakistan. Our services include complete range of plastic surgery that can be possible at any of the world best center. From the simple contracture to very complex brachial plexus and free flap, we reconstruct Head and Neck tumors with free flap by Microvascular SURGERY. This is the kind of surgery in which we anastomose 2mm or less artery and vein under microscope with hair thin sutures.

DOTS is helping us with these patients. As they need hair thin sutures 8/0 and 9/0 for restoration of artery and vein connection. We usually need special steel clips for bleeding control and also skin stapler for closure of wounds. All these things are provided to us by DOTS. It takes 6-8hrs to complete this surgery and we routinely do it on every Monday. Till date we have done 70 free flaps. That is a very big number considering the complexity of procedure. We thank DOTS for providing us with the above mentioned surgical stuff.



World Pharmacist day


World Pharmacists Day was organized in DOTS auditorium on 28th September 2016. The event was celebrated around the globe sixth time in the honor
